- The butterfly symbol is for transformation—hope and challenges—like a timely and accurate assessment
- The colours of healing are strong but peaceful. They are soothing to look at in contrast to the terror you are feeling
- These butterflies are on a journey to freedom behind a soft cloud which sits over them like a veil while they grow stronger
- Then they break loose, and like the top butterfly which has left the veil, they glow with colour: free
- The single butterfly at right is the therapist. The group of three on the left are the supporting family and friends.
