## RIGHTS OF MEMBERS OF NSW CAG

Only individuals who have been a member of NSW CAG for at least 6 months have the right to:

- Nominate as a Trustee of NSW CAG when positions become available
- Vote in new Trustees to the NSW CAG Board
- Vote at Annual General Meetings and Special General Meetings or have a proxy vote for them

All members of NSW CAG have right to:

- Attend the Annual General Meeting
- Attend Special General Meetings
- Receive NSW CAG weekly E-News and quarterly newsletter
- Participate in all NSW CAG consultations and other events

All members of NSW CAG have the responsibility to renew membership every three years
